A word from Pastor Sarah Wanck



Marion Aldersgate Family,

As you read this, Gabe, Hudson, and I are likely unpacking boxes and settling into our new home on East Patton Drive; and still in joyful disbelief that we can call Marion and Aldersgate home. When you enter into ministry in the Methodist Church and agree to itineracy (being moved from church to church), one of the painful decisions involved is knowing that a "yes" to the call of ministry likely means moving away from home. From the moments Gabe and I said yes to ministry, we've lived in three different states, served in ten different churches, and lived in eight different homes (this one makes nine). John and Lisa Hamilton serve with One Mission Society since 1993.

They pastored in Colombia for 10 years, helping to establish two strong churches by pioneering youth, parenting and small group ministry among relatively unreached populations in North Bogota

and South Medellin. The Hamiltons relocated to Montevideo,

Uruguay in 2003 with an international missionary team. Since 2005, they pastor Christ Church which has unexpectedly

grown to become a dynamic, bilingual, multicultural church, absolutely unique in the entire south side of the city. John is the Latino Emotionally Healthy Discipleship Coach. He and Lisa have served on local and Regional leadership teams for Alpha, Community Bible Study, Godly Play and SIM UY. John has taught on discipleship in Seminaries in the region, including to Latino missionaries in Pakistan. He and Lisa connect frequently with Latino pastors and leaders on issues of personal discipleship.
